The spinning wheel is a device used to spin fibers into yarn. It consists of a large wheel (the flyer) and a smaller wheel (the bobbin) that rotate together. The fibers are fed into the center and spun into a continuous thread. The spinning wheel is a traditional tool used in textile production.
