The Błażowa Commune is situated in the central Dynów Foothills. The townlet of Błażowa was likely established in the early Middle Ages. Several old houses, typical of towns in historic Galicia, have survived to this day.

The parish church of St. Martin, constructed between 1896 and 1900 based on Jan Sas-Zubrzycki's designs, is undoubtedly the most significant cultural monument and jewel of Błażowa.

Colourful folk traditions are disappearing, and social customs are changing. Old documents are becoming damaged, and local stories and legends are fading away.

The Informal Historical Group "To Save From Obscurity" was established to collect, preserve, and share the achievements of our ancestors, particularly with the younger generation. Through this effort, we aim to enrich their understanding of our region's history and the people who shaped it. We connect generations by educating young people and gathering stories from seniors. This way, we aim to preserve elements of the intangible cultural heritage of the Błażowa region, ensuring that the memory of past places and events continues.

This map marks the start of a larger project. Due to technical constraints, it currently includes only a dozen or so notable places worth exploring or revisiting. More locations will be added gradually. We hope this will serve as an interesting tourist guide to the historical sites in the Błażowa Commune.


